If a Muslim gives another person clothes who is in need, he will be rewarded clothing from

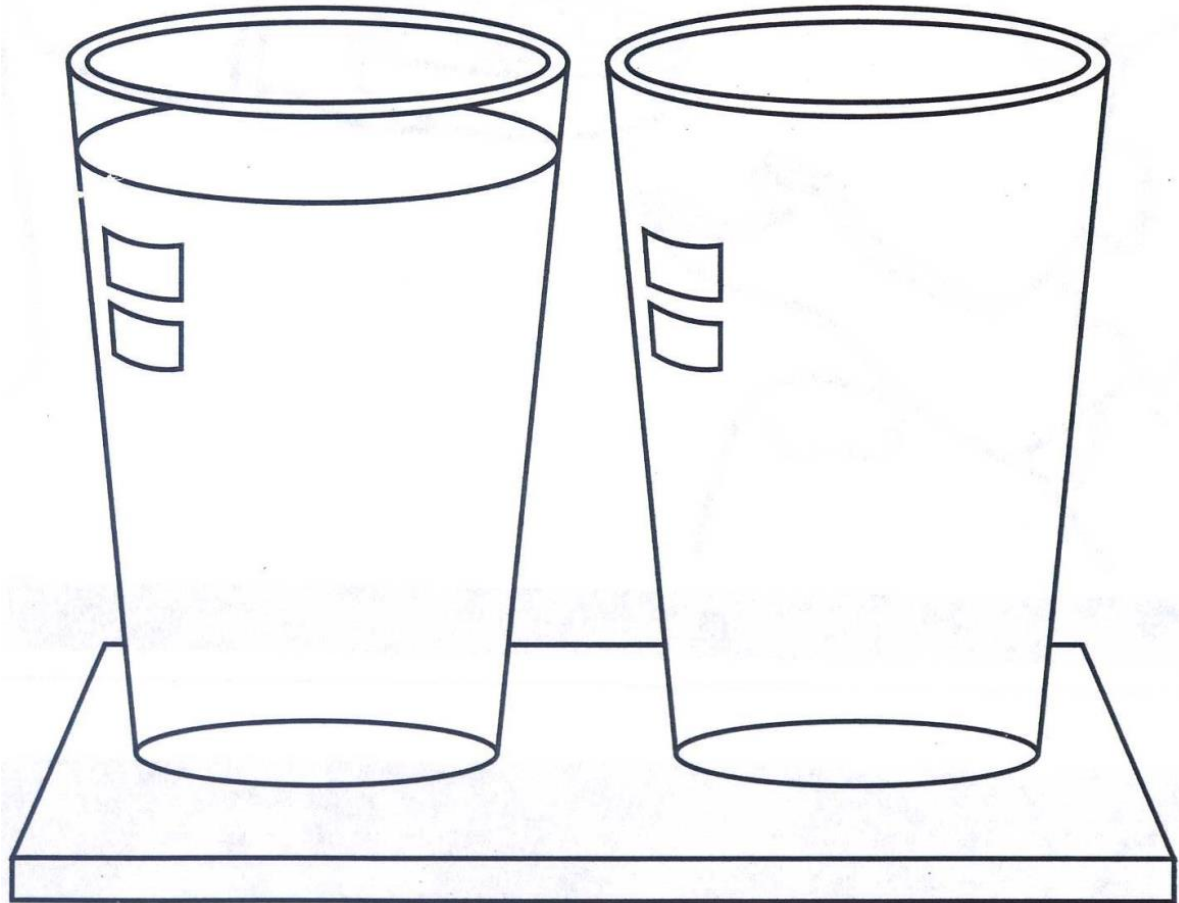

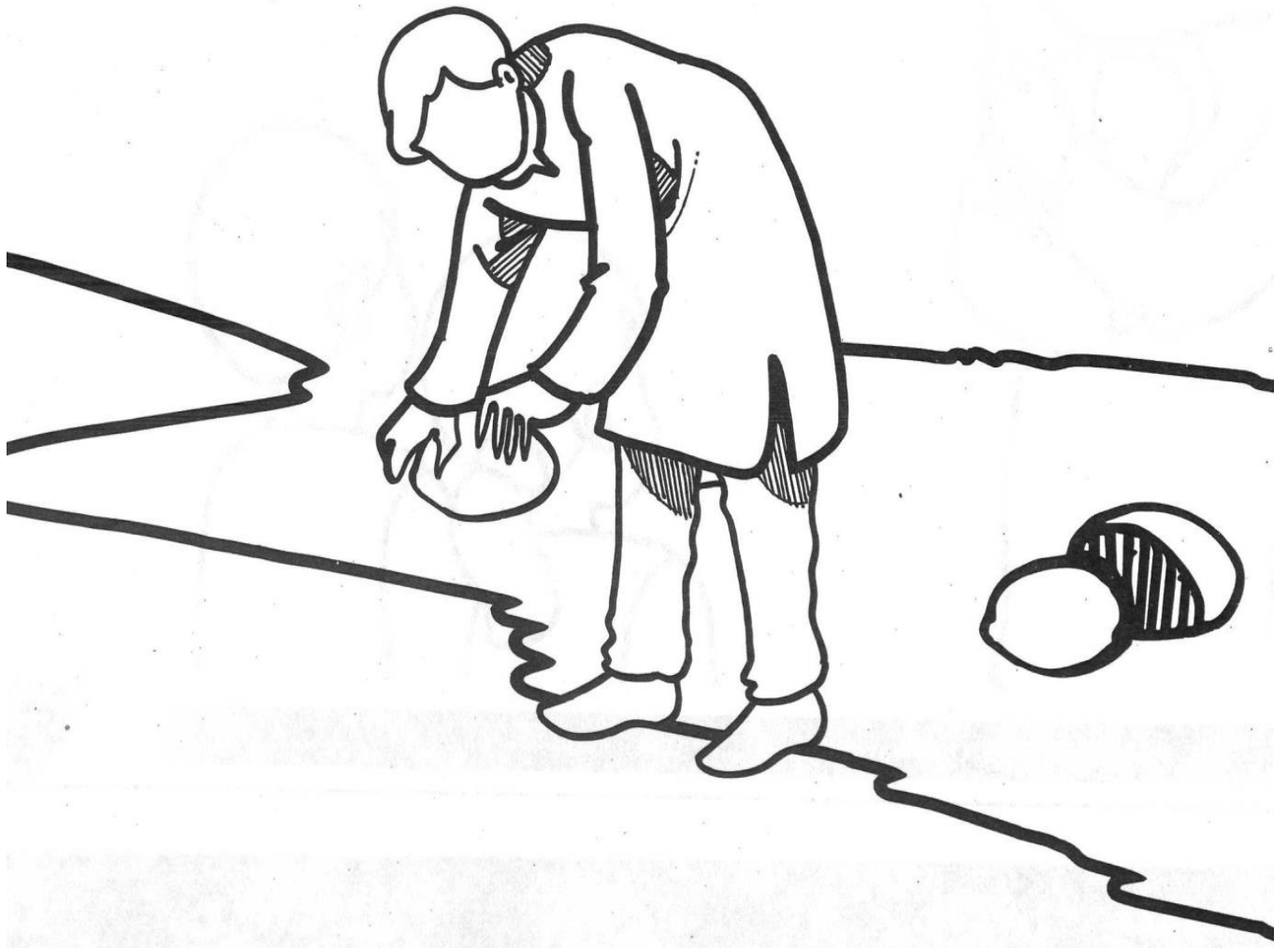
When someone plants a tree or crops in a farm which gives food for birds, men and animals, the eating of it will be counted as charity for them.

harms human life and honour.



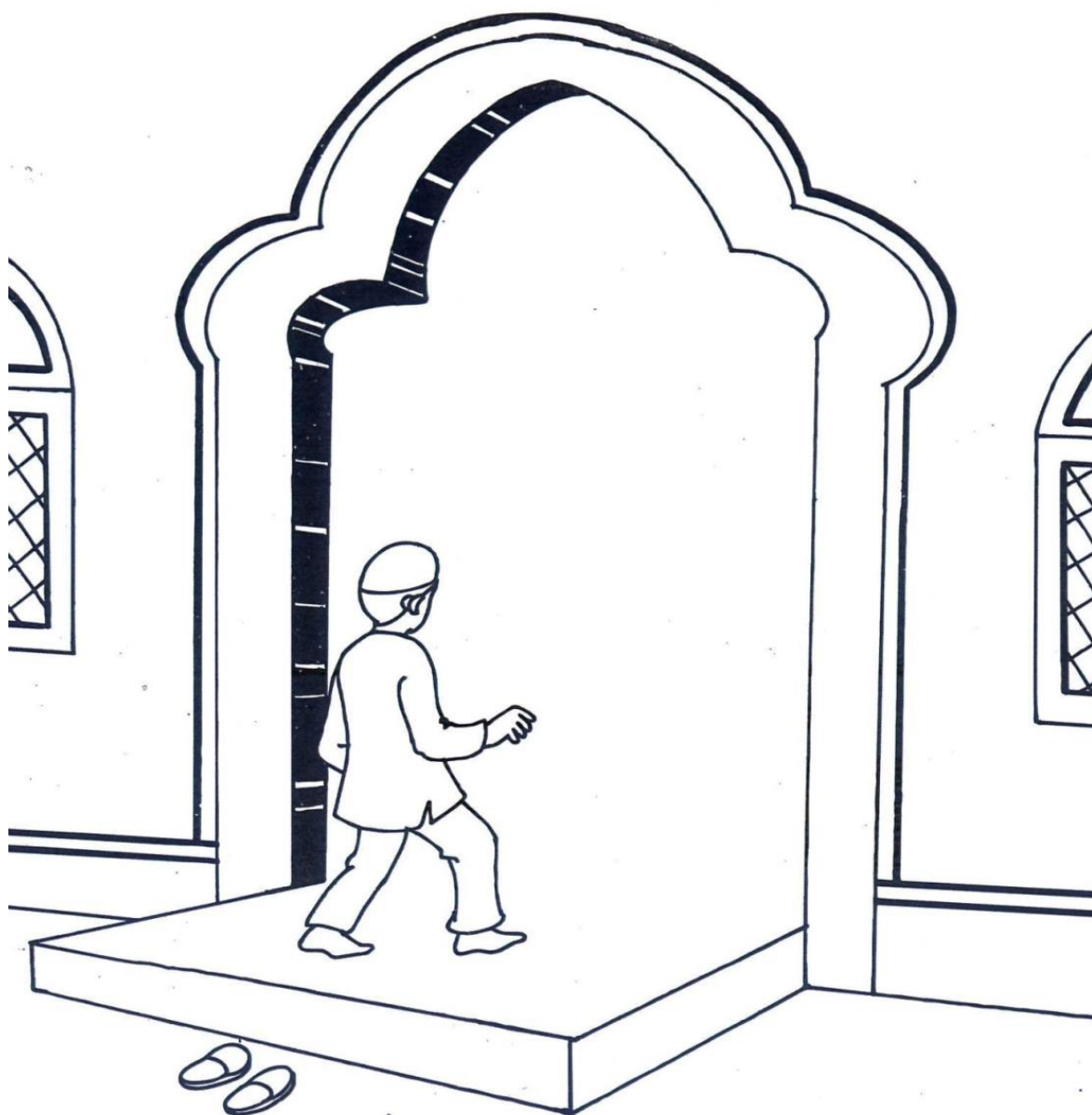
Removing a harmful thing from the path or road is charity (Sadaqah).
