Anyone who hits his servant will be punished on the Day of Judgement.




Every step you take to perform prayers is a charity (Sadaqa).



Whoever helps and protects a person, Allah will protect them in this world and the next.




Salaah in Jama'ah (with people) is better than Salaah by one's self in one's house twenty-seven times.




Cleanliness is half of one's faith (Iman).



Some things the past Prophet's (upon them be peace) would do is Salaam, brushing the teeth with Miswak and using Itr.




You will not become a true Muslim until you have love for each other.




When someone plants a tree or crops in a farm which gives food for birds, men and animals, the eating of it will be counted as charity for them.



A Muslim will never take part in anything that harms human life and honour.









Du'a at the time of coming out of the Masjid:
