
"...Allah is with us."





"The first ones to drink from the Fountain of Kauthar will be my Ahle Bayt and those who loved me." (KanzulUmmal)

"The most-firm footed ones on the bridge on the Day of judgment will be those who love my Ahle Bayt and Companions the most." (KanzulUmmal)

The Prophet (may Allah bless him and grant him peace), Sayyidina Ali, Sayyida Fatima, Sayyidina Imam Hasan and Sayyidina Imam Hussain are collectively called Panj Tan Paak (five pure ones). The wives of the Prophet are collectively known as Azwaaj e Muttahharaat (pure wives) or the Ummahaatul Mu'mineen (mothers of the believers).






At the same time, Sayyidina Isa will appear on the eastern






Imam Mahdi



An enormous (big) earthquake will shake the earth.



The great intercession

The people will declare the greatness and dignity of these Prophets and request for their intercession. All of them will proclaim: "We are worried about ourselves. We can't present your case in the court of Allah Almighty."

Finally, they will approach Our Beloved Prophet (may Allah bless him and grant him peace). He will announce, "Today, this Rank is only for me."

He will enter the Court of Allah Almighty and will prostrate in Sajdah before Him.

Allah Almighty will say, "O Muhammad, Raise your head.

Speak, you will be heard.

Request, you will be granted.

Intercede, your intercession will be accepted."

Thus he will obtain the release from Hell for all believers.

The scale of justice


This is a Divine balance. All good and bad deeds will be weighted on it. This scale will be unlike the scales of this world. Its plate of good deeds will rise upwards.

bless him and grant him peace) will be present and will be praying for the salvation of his followers.




