Allah Almighty


- 1. Allah is The One.




Lesson three (3)


The Qur'an

The Qur'an

- 1. The longest chapter of the Qur'an is Surah Baqarah (2nd Surah in Qur'an).
- 2. The shortest chapter of the Qur'an is Surah Kowthar.
- 3. The Qur'an has 30 parts (Para) and 114 Chapters (Surahs).
- 4. It has two orders of succession; the sequence of revelation and the sequence arranged in book form. Both of them are revelation from Allah (The Exalted). It was not revealed in the order we have it in today.
- 5. The memorising of the Qur'an by common people is its miracle. Other divine books were memorised by the Prophets alone.
- 6. Previous books were revealed to certain people and areas. However, the Qur'an is guidance for all humanity. People of all times, areas and nations can benefit from its teachings.


- 1. Allah Almighty bestowed him with unlimited knowledge, more so than anyone in his creation.

- 6. He will be the first to raise from his grave on the day of Resurrection.
- 7. He is the reason for the existence of creation. If he was not created, nothing would have been created.
- 8. It is essential to recite Durood upon hearing, writing and speaking his name.
- 9. It is forbidden to write the short form of Durood (e.g. S, SAW, and PBUH etc.) after his name.
- 10. It is desirable/a good deed (mustahab) to kiss the thumb nails and rub them over the eye lids out of love and respect, upon hearing his blessed name (Everybody do this!)
- 11. He is alive in his grave. He observes the universe. He can go wherever he wills.
- 12. Pious men see him in dreams and also while awake.
- 13. Shaytan cannot take his form.

- 14. He narrated prophecies in abundance (What will happen in future).
- 15. Offering his Waseelah (intercession) in the Court of Allah Almighty enable prayers to be accepted.

Lesson sixteen (16)

The Family of the Prophet (Sallallahu Alayhi Wassallam)

- 1. Sayyidah Faatimah is one of the daughters of the Prophet (may Allah bless him and grant him peace). His children began only from her. Her descendants are called Aale Muhammad and Sayyid, Ale Rasool etc.
- 2. It is obligatory for Muslims to respect Sadaat-e-Kiram.
- 3. It is prohibited for Sadaat to take Sadaqah and Zakaah.
- 4. The Prophet (may Allah bless him and grant him peace) said: These Sadaqaat are dirt (of the wealth or hands) of people and they are not allowed for Muhammad (may Allah bless him and grant him peace) and his family. (Muslim)
- 5. Muslims should offer them gifts from their pure wealth.
- 6. The family, children and wives of the Prophet (may Allah bless him and grant him peace) are called the Ahle Bayt. They had two distinct qualities;
- 1. Relationship to the Prophet (may Allah bless him and grant him peace).

2. Companionship of the Prophet (may Allah bless him and grant him peace). Allah Almighty mentioned their greatness in The Qur'an: O inhabitants of the Prophet's house! Allah Almighty intends to remove impurity from you and to purify you thoroughly." (Al Ahzab: 33)

The Prophet (may Allah bless him and grant him peace) mentioned their virtues as well: "The example of my Ahle Bayt is like that of the Ark of SayyidinaNuh. Whoever embarks it will survive and whoever remains behind will perish." (Mishkat)

"My Ahle Bayt are the Aman (safe Keeping) for my Ummah."

(KanzulUmmal)

"The first ones to drink from the Fountain of Kauthar will be my Ahle Bayt and those who loved me." (KanzulUmmal)

"The most-firm footed ones on the bridgr on the Day of judgment will be those who love my Ahle Bayt and Companions the most."

(KanzulUmmal)

The Prophet (may Allah bless him and grant him peace), Sayyidina Ali, Sayyida Fatima, Sayyidalman Hasan and Sayyidina Imam Hussain are collectively called Panj Tan Paak (five pure ones). The wives of the Prophet are collectively known as Azwaaj e Muttahharaat (pure wives) or the Ummahaat ul Mu'mineen (mothers of the believers).

The blessed Companions (Sahaba)

- 1. A Sahabi is a person who met our beloved Prophet Muhammad (may Allah bless him and grant him peace) in his physical life whilst awake and in the state of Iman and he remained a Muslim until his death.
- 2. All blessed sahabah were just, pious and respectable.
- 3. The Prophet said: Respect and honour my sahabah because they are more excellent and better than you. (Mishkat)
- 4. The blessed sahabah are criterion for faith and guidance.
- 5. Whoever follows their path is on the path of true guidance.
- 6. Whoever disregards their path goes astray.

The Prophet (may Allah bless him and grant him peace) said:

"My Companions are like the stars. Whoever you follow from them, you will surely find guidance." (Mishkat)

7. Sayyidina Abu Bakr Siddique has the highest rank amongst them, then Sayyidina Umar-e-Farooq, Sayyidina Uthman-e-Ghani and Sayyidina Ali.

- 8. These four blessed sahabah also called the four friends (Chaar Yaar).
- 9. In this order they are the first four Caliphs of Islam.

- 5. All blessed sahaabah will enter Paradise. Causing insult to any of the blessed sahabah results in harm to the beloved Prophet (may Allah bless him and grant him peace).

- 1. Wilaayat (sainthood) is a special gift of Allah Almighty which He bestowed upon His unique and beloved servants.
- 2. This status can also be obtained through the pursuits of knowledge, excellence, worship and thought.
- 3. Awliya is plural of Wali.
- 4. Wali is a special servant of Allah Almighty who sacrifices all his desires in order to show utmost sacrifices to Allah Almighty and His Prophet and obeys their orders throughout his life.
- 5. A wali can never be ignorant of essential Islamic in his life.
- 6. His deeds can never oppose Shari'ah.

- 7. A person who considers himself exempt from the laws of Shari'ah cannot be a Wali. The Awliya-e-Kiram the true heirs of the Prophet (may Allah bless him and grant him peace). Allah Almighty grants them special spiritual powers.
- 8. They have ability to perform miracles (Karamat).



Dajjal will begin to dissolve with the fragrance of Sayyidina Isa's blessed breath as salt dissolves in water. Dajjal will try to flee. Sayyidina Isa will chase him and launch a spear into his back. Thus he will be killed.

In the age of Sayyidina Isa, everybody will become wealthy. There will be plenty of wealth. There will be love and affection everywhere. Sayyidina Isaa will break the Cross and will kill the swine (pig).

Major Signs of Qiyamah

Yajooj and Majooj

When the Muslims reach Mount Toor, Yajooj and Majooj will appear. They will be in such large numbers that just a group of them will drink and finish the water of a river ten miles long. They will cause destruction and murder everywhere. Once they finish causing chaos on the earth, they will say: "We have killed the residents of the earth; let us now kill the residents of the skies."

On saying this they will fire their arrows into the skies. By the will of Allah Almighty their arrows will come back with blood on them.

Now by the supplication of Sayyidina Isa worms will infest their necks. Due to this, they will die. Sayyidina Isa will then come down from Mount Toor. Due to the foul smell of their decaying dead body. Sayyidina Isa will pray again.

Flocks of big birds will come and carry away their decaying corpse. Then it will rain and there will be greenery everywhere and an abundance of sustenance (food).

Smoke

After the death of Sayyidina Isa, once again ignorance will slowly begin to spread throughout the world. Then a specific type of smoke will begin to spread from the skies and it will spread over the earth.

Qiyamah

No Muslims will remain at all. There will be kufr everywhere. People will be busy in their own work. Suddenly, Qiyamah will be established. Allah Almighty will order Sayyidina Israfil to blow the trumpet. He will comply. At first, the sound of the trumpet will be low. It will gradually increase. Until finally, it will become horrifying. Everyone will fall unconscious and then die.

An enormous earthquake will shake the earth. Mountains will float in the sky like cotton. The sun, moon and stars will all perish and become lightless. Everything in existence will become non-existent. Nothing will exist except Allah Almighty. On that day Allah Almighty will say:

For whom is the Kingdom today?

Allah Almighty then Himself will answer:

"It is for non but Allah Almighty, The only One, The Destroyer."

Resurrection

Almighty Allah will revive Sayyidina Israfil and restore the trumpet, which will be blown again. After its blowing, everyone will re-exist.

First of all the Prophet (may Allah bless him and grant him peace) will come out from his grave holding the hand Sayydina Abu Bakr in his right hand and Sayyidina Umar in his other right.²

All of mankind will go to the Field of Resurrection. It will be a fearful day. The earth will be of copper. The sun will be just one mile above the earth. We cannot even imagine the heat of that day. The degree of heat that is felt will depend on ones deeds. Everyone will be worried about their own suffering, that day will be equal to 50,000 years of worldly life. For pious people it will last just a few moments.

The great intercession

In those circumstances, people will look for someone to present their case in the court of Allah Almighty, and intercede for them, they will approach Sayyidina Adam, SayyidinaNuh, Sayyidina Musa, and Sayyidina Isa (peace be upon them). The people will declare the greatness and dignity of these Prophets and request for their intercession. All of them will proclaim: "We are worried about ourselves. We can't present your case in the court of Allah Almighty."

Finally, they will approach Our Beloved Prophet. He will announce, "Today, this Rank is only for me."

He will enter the Court of Allah Almighty and will prostrate in Sajdah before Him.

Dua: O Allah! Make our teachers, us, our families and friends good deeds outway our bad deeds, ameen!

The bridge over hell

This has been spread over the Hell. It is finer than a hair and sharper than the edge of a sword. Everyone will have to pass over it. It will be the only way to reach Paradise. Our Prophet will cross it first. People will cross it at different speeds. Some of them at the speed of lightening. Some of them by crawling like ants. The speed will vary between these two extremes. Some people will fall into hell. Our Prophet will be present and will be praying for the salvation of his followers.

Dua: O Allah! For the sake of Your beloved give us the ability to go pass the bridge without realising.

Paradise

This is created for the believers. The beauty of its blessings is unimaginable. Everything it contains is extremely beautiful. It is made of gold, silver, musk, and precious stones. It has rivers of water, milk,

honey and heavenly wine. All kinds of foods and drinks will be available.

There will not be any type of un-cleanliness. People will have different grades according to their worldly deeds. They will have servants. They will have what they wish. The most respectable people of paradise will have the honour of seeing Allah Almighty and His beloved Prophet (may Allah bless him and grant him peace).

Destiny (Fate) Tagdeer

- 1. Allah (The Exalted) has the knowledge of everything before its creation.
- 2. Allah (The Exalted) has given human beings the will power and the ability of doing good or bad.
- 3. Allah's knowledge of what good or bad one would do even before one is created is called Taqdeer or Destiny. The reason it is written is because the person was going to do it and not because Allah has written it.
- 4. All favours are by Allah's will alone and no misfortune can happen except by the will of Allah (The Exalted).
- 5. Therefore we should not despair over any misfortune or boast over any favour. This teaches us that we should be thankful to Allah (The Exalted) for his favours and patients over any misfortune.
