Chapter Four

The Prophet صَلَّى اللَّهُ عَلَيْهِ وَالِهِ وَسَلَّم being mentioned in the Adhan¹ during the era of Sayyiduna Aadam عَلَيْهِ السَّلَام and in the Highest Kingdom

Sayyiduna Aadam عَلَيْهِ السَّلَام asked, "Who is Muhammad (صَلَّى اللَّهُ عَلَيْهِ وَالِهِ وَسَلَّم) Sayyiduna Jibreel "?(صَلَّى اللَّهُ عَلَيْهِ وَالِهِ وَسَلَّم) amongst your children."

2. Imam Bazzaar (d.292 AH) رَضِيَ اللهُ عَلَيْهِ وَاللهِ وَسَلَّم narrates from Sayyiduna 'Ali عَزَّوَجَلَ who said; "When Allah عَزَّوَجَلَ willed to teach the Adhan (call to prayer) to His Prophet مَلَى اللهُ عَلَيْهِ وَاللهِ وَسَلَّم sayyiduna Jibreel عَلَيْهِ السَّلَام came with an animal called Buraq. When the Prophet عَلَيْهِ السَّلَام intended to ride the Buraq, it became nervous (startled). Sayyiduna Jibreel عَلَيْهِ السَّلَام said, "Be steady, by Allah (عَزَّوَجَل), no bondsman more virtuous than (Sayyiduna) Muhammad (عَزَّوَجَل) has ever mounted you." The Prophet (صَلَّى اللهُ عَلَيْهِ وَاللهِ وَسَلَّم) mounted it until they came to a great veil that is close to the Court of the Merciful (Allah عَزَّوَجَلُ). An Angel came from behind the veil and said;

It was said to him from behind the veil;

صدق عبدي لا إله إلا أنا

"My bondsman spoke the truth, there is none worthy of worship but I."

Then the Angel عَلَيْهِ السَّلَام said;

وَأَشْهَدُ أَنَّ مُحَمَّدًا رَّسُوْلُ اللهِ

(صَلَّى اللَّهُ عَلَيْهِ وَالِهِ وَسَلَّم) I bear witness that Muhammad is the Messenger of Allah

It was said from behind the veil;

"My servant spoke the truth. I sent Muhammad as a Messenger." (صَلَّى اللَّهُ عَلَيْهِ وَالِهِ وَسَلَّم)

After this, the Angel عَلَيْهِ السَّلَام said;

Rush to prayer حَيَّ عَلَى الصَّلَاةِ

Rush to success حَيَّ عَلَى الْفَلَاحِ

Prayer is to begin قَدْ قَامَتِ الصَّلَاةُ

Then he said;

اَللهُ أَكْبَرُ Allah is The Greatest

It was said from behind the veil;

صدق عبدي أنا أكبر "My servant spoke the truth. I am the Greatest, I am the Greatest."

Then the Angel عَلَيْهِ السَّلَام said;

لَّا إِلَهَ إِلَّا اللهُ There is no deity except Allah

It was said from behind the veil;

صدق عبدي لا إله إلا أنا

"My bondsman spoke the truth, there is none worthy of worship but I."

After this, the Angel held the hand of the Prophet مَلَى اللَّهُ عَلَيْهِ وَالِهِ وَسَلَّم and sent him مَلَى اللَّهُ عَلَيْهِ وَالِهِ وَسَلَّم forward. Sayyiduna Aadam and Sayyiduna Nuh عَلَيْهِمُ السَّلَام were amongst the dwellers of the heavens. Allah صَلَّى اللَّهُ عَلَيْهِ وَالِهِ وَسَلَّم over the dwellers of the heavens and the earth on that day.
