Sign in relation to the blessed intelligence of the Prophet صَلَّى اللَّهُ عَلَيْهِ وَآلِهِ وَسَلَّمَ

Imam Abu Nu'aym (d. 430 AH) in (his book) Hilyah and Imam Ibn Asakir (d. 571 AH) عَلَيْهِمُ الرِّضْوَانُ extracted a narration from Sayyiduna Wahb ibn Munabih رَضِيَ اللَّهُ عَنْهُ who stated, "I read seventy-one books and I found in all of them that Allah (عَزَّوَجَلَّ) has not granted intellect to all the people from the beginning of time to the end of time in comparison to the Prophet (صَلَّى اللَّهُ عَلَيْهِ وَآلِهِ وَسَلَّمَ) except like a small piece of sand from all the sand of the world. And (without doubt) the Prophet صَلَّى اللَّهُ عَلَيْهِ وَآلِهِ وَسَلَّمَ has the most intelligence from the people and has the highest level of opinion."
