Section in relation to the sign that the Prophet ﷺ had no shadow seen

Imam Tirmidhi (d. 297 AH) رَحِمَهُ اللهُ عَلَيْهِ extracted a narration from Sayyiduna Dhakwaan رَضِيَ اللهُ عَنْهُ who stated that a shadow wasn't seen for the Messenger of Allah ﷺ neither in the sun nor the moon.

Imam Ibn Sab'a (d. 558 AH) رَحِمَهُ اللهُ عَلَيْهِ stated that from specialities of the Prophet ﷺ that his blessed shadow would not fall on the earth, and the Prophet ﷺ was Noor (light). So when he (ﷺ) would walk in the sun or the moon, there would not be a shadow seen of him ﷺ. Some of the scholars stated that a Hadith testifies to this, in which the Prophet ﷺ said in his dua (supplication);

واجعلني نورا

And make me light.
