

Chapter Forty-One

Section in relation to the sign that flies would not touching the Prophet

صَلَّى اللّٰهُ عَلَيْهِ وَاٰلِهٖ وَسَلَّم nor his blessed clothes

1. Imam Qadhi Iyad (d. 544 AH) in Kitab al-Shifa and Imam Azafvi (d. 633 AH) عَلَيْهِمُ الرِّضْوَانُ in his book "Al-Mawlid" stated that from amongst the specialities of the Messenger of Allah صَلَّى اللّٰهُ عَلَيْهِ وَاٰلِهٖ وَسَلَّم is that the flies would not come upon him صَلَّى اللّٰهُ عَلَيْهِ وَاٰلِهٖ وَسَلَّم.
2. Imam Ibn Sab'a (d. 558 AH) in Khasais mentioned it with the wording, "Flies never came upon his صَلَّى اللّٰهُ عَلَيْهِ وَاٰلِهٖ وَسَلَّم clothing." He added that from his صَلَّى اللّٰهُ عَلَيْهِ وَاٰلِهٖ وَسَلَّم specialities is that lice never troubled him (the Prophet صَلَّى اللّٰهُ عَلَيْهِ وَاٰلِهٖ وَسَلَّم never had any lice).
